Anita Meffley was reunited Thursday, March 30, 2017 with her loving husband, Richard, as she peacefully passed away. Anita was born to Stanley & Margurite (Hyatt) Hincelot, who lived in Mountain View, CA on January 17, 1925. Anita attended the University of Nevada, where she pledged as a legacy member of the Kappa Alpha Theta sorority and where she met her future husband, who was a member of the Sigma Nu fraternity. Anita and Richard were married after his graduation in 1948 and settled in Sacramento. Anita has resided in Fresno, CA. since 1963, when Richard was transferred. Anita was a homemaker, but she also donated her time to the Assistance League of Fresno and supported the Kappa Alpha Theta Foundation in which she was a Lifetime member. She enjoyed traveling with Richard to Northern California Golf Association tournaments in Monterey, and to the USGA Senior Amateur Championship, where Richard served on the rules committee. In her spare time Anita enjoyed playing bridge, reading, watching golf tournaments and spending time with her family.
