Charles C. Fenton born November 13, 1923 to parents Charles T. Fenton and Mildred R. Culver in the Village of Medina, New York. He died October 10, 2014 in Clovis, Ca with his family by his side.

His life began in Medina New York as the oldest surviving child of Charles and Mildred with an infant older sister who died a few days after birth. He had 2 younger brothers Robert and Howard. He graduated from Camillus High School in 1942. He enlisted in the Army during World War 2 serving in the company G 159th infantry for 4 years discharging in 1946.
