A lifelong resident of Fresno and Clovis, CA, Chuck was a graduate of Clovis High School, Class of 1962. He attended Fresno City College where he majored in engineering and architecture. He served from 1965-1967 with the US Army Specialist (E4) 4th Battalion 28th Artillery. He was stationed in Fort Sill, OK and served in Vietnam.

Upon returning to Fresno, he used his engineering, architectural and military training to open his own business. He designed, built, and operated “Big Dreamer” and “San Joaquin Tungsten Mines and Mill” in North Fork, CA from 1968 to 1978.

Coming down the mountain in 1978, Chuck continued working with his favorite things; heavy equipment and big trucks for Kamm Ave Disposal, Williams Excavation, DTS, State Wide Excavation and then returned to William Excavation parttime until his death.

Chuck loved trains and model railroading, collecting stamps, reading history debates and a “really good argument”, supported 4-H and FFA (of which he was a member growing up), and spending time with his nephews, nieces,

grand nephews, and grandnieces. He will be greatly missed by family and friends.
