



Charles P. "Chuck" Roberts

Charles, who was born and died in Fresno, California is survived by his two children, Charylou and Richard Roberts, his two granddaughters Lindsey and Shelby Roberts, and his great-granddaughter Nora.

Charles Roberts was a member of the U.S. Army, completing his service in 1945 with the end of WWII. After the war, he graduated from Fresno State University with a degree in accounting. He then went on to work for Chevron. During his university years he met Bobby Lou White, who he then married in 1952. He survived her death in 2016, marking the end of their 64-year marriage.

Upon retirement, both Chuck and Bobby enjoyed traveling the world, collecting memories and memorabilia from Russia to New Zealand. They spent every summer at the family cabin at Huntington Lake. Both were also steadfast and active members of the Fort Washington Golf and Country Club. Chuck enjoyed his many years of membership, golfing until shortly before his death.

Chuck is remembered as a kind and generous man, beloved and missed by all his family. He survived Stage 4 Cancer, not once but twice, outlasting doctors' prognosis of death by 8 years. He attributed his longevity to his love of golf and walking 1-2 miles every day around his neighborhood, even at 97.
