Cirilo P. Pamandanan was born to Norberto and Leonida Pamandanan in San Simon, Pampanga, Philippines on May 12, 1936. He was retired custodian for the Veteran's Administration Hospital of Fresno.

Prior to his service at the Veteran's Administration, Cirilo served in the United States Navy. Upon completion of 10 years of service with the Navy, he went on to enlist in the United States Army Reserves where he would serve until his retirement as a Staff Sergeant.

Cirilo enjoyed life to the fullest. His favorite pastimes were spent playing poker and visiting the local casinos with his wife Linda. Together, they engaged with the community whether it was the Veteran's of Foreign Wars or the Filipino American Association of Fresno and Vicinity.

He is preceded in death by his parents, his siblings, Felicisimo Pamandanan, Wenceslao Pamandanan and Pacifico Pamandanan.
