Emilia was born in Jalostotitlan, Jalisco, Mexico on December 16, 1960 to Trinidad and Carmen Gutierrez. She was suddenly taken on the evening of Thursday, January 26, 2015 due to injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

In Emilia's earlier years, she studied in a convent in Mexico to become a nun. Emilia later found her calling was something other than religious life. She met and married her husband Joaquin and later had two children. Emilia was a devoted wife and mother always tending to her family. She also took pride in housekeeping tending to various priests in the diocese of Fresno.

Emilia is survived by her husband Joaquin; her two sons, Luis Carrasco and Diego Carrasco.

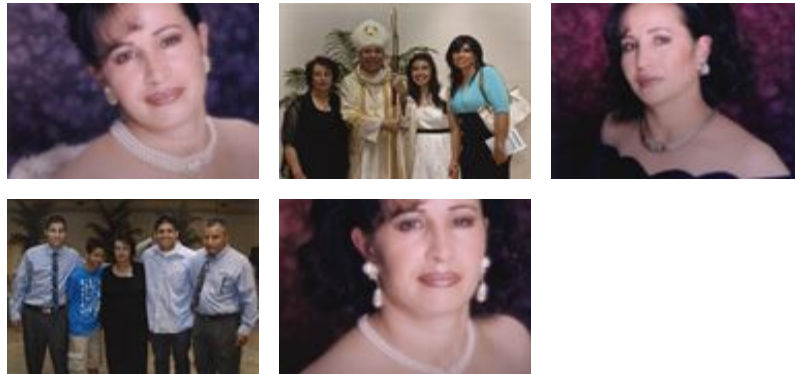
