Our dear mother, Enedina Mariscal Zamorano passed away on November 8, 2023, at the age of 82. She was born on February 21, 1941, in San Marcos, Jalisco, Mexico. She traveled with her children across Mexico to America, not knowing the language, the people or where we would call home. On our travels, she set up small eateries and sold her delicious food. She was so resourceful, and we admired how she would not give up; she would make ends meet with so little for so many of us and others that

were struggling like us. Mother knew so many trades, she was a great cook, a seamstress, a natural healer, and was a hardworking-financial savvy lady. She forged ahead until her dream of owning our own home was accomplished. Our mother taught us responsibility at a young age, respect, hard work, and determination. She wanted us to dream big and accomplish the impossible. Mother often said, “No dejes para mañana lo que puedes acer hoy” or “Don’t leave things for tomorrow when you can accomplish them today,” her way of expressing for us to keep on going.

She will be missed dearly by those she touched.

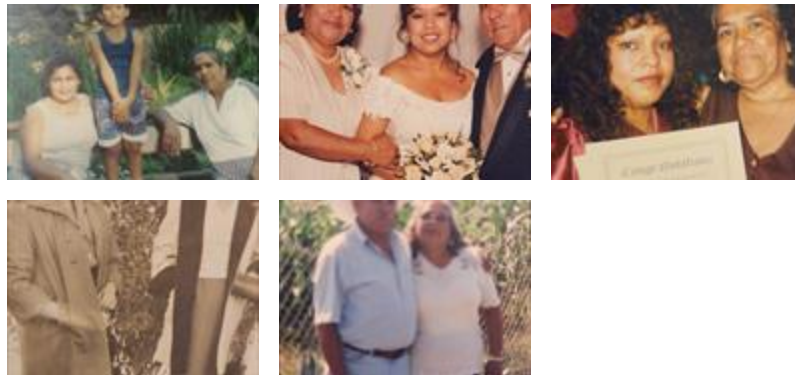
