Dr. Forest Vaughan Young, age 86, passed away peacefully in his home on Tuesday evening, May 29, 2018, with his wife of 61 years, Nancy, at his side.

Born in Oakland, CA on June 5, 1931, to Fred and Marie Young, he was the younger brother of the late Pat Shafer, and Marion Myer and is survived by his younger sister, Shirley Mizener King. He was raised in Merced, CA, where he met his wife.
