October 5, 1941 - August 21, 2018

Fou Seng Saelee passed peacefully from this life the evening of August 21, 2018 at Community Regional Medical Center after a gradual decline in health. He was surrounded and supported by his loving family during the last days of his life.

Fou Seng was born in Laos on October 5, 1941. Fou Seng was enlisted by the U.S. Army to assist during the Vietnam conflict, his service lasted two years and promoted to the rank of Sergeant. Shortly thereafter, he brought his family to Thailand where they stayed for approximately six years in the refugee camp.

In 1980, his family was sponsored by the Bellingham Christian Reform Church where he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior. In 1987, he moved to Fresno to be closer to his family. Fou Seng was an active member of his community. His motto, "Serving others first". Fou Seng will be remembered as a person that would put others first when called upon. His generous spirit will be remembered by those that he influenced and cared for.

Fou Seng is survived by two sons, one daughter and six grandchildren.
