



Hisako Iwamoto

May 17, 1923 - April 27, 2017

Hisa Iwamoto died peacefully at home on April 27, 2017 at the age of 93. She was born Hisako Nakamura on May 17, 1923 in Wapato, Washington, the eldest of five children. She attended public school and graduated high school in 1941. When the war broke out with Japan during World War II, Hisa and her family were evacuated to the internment camp at Heart Mountain in Wyoming. After her release from camp, Hisa eventually moved to New York, where she met and married Richard "Dick" Iwamoto and had her first son, Glenn. The couple later moved to California where they shared a home in Fowler with Dick's mother and father. Soon there after her second son, Randy, was born. Hisa later took on the task of becoming caregiver to both her in-laws as well as her own mother. In addition, Hisa was employed for many years by the Fowler Packing Company and became one of its most loyal and valued employees. She was also a lifetime member of the Fowler Buddhist Church to which she devoted many hours of service. People were drawn to Hisa's warmth, welcoming personality and great sense of humor. The times she loved the most were those spent with her family and friends.

Hisa leaves behind her beloved son Glenn Iwamoto (Jill), cherished grandsons Blair and Brooks, sister Ginger Hirakawa (Harry) and sister-in-law Sanaye "Snookie" Iwamoto. She is preceded in death by her husband Dick, son Randy, brothers Minoru, Gichi and sister Mae Kitaguchi. She is also survived by nieces and nephews and their families as well as many friends

who all love her and will miss her dearly.
