Wayne Holman, a devoted man of faith, courage, and service, passed away on October 8, 2025. Born in Atlas, Oklahoma on January 20, 1949. Wayne lived a life dedicated to God, his family, and his country.

At just 11 years old, Wayne was ordained in the Church of God organization—marking the beginning of a lifelong calling to ministry. He went on to serve faithfully within the Pentecostal Church of God, working in the Indian Missions Department at the National Headquarters in Joplin, Missouri, and later as the Southern California Youth Director, where he inspired countless young people with his leadership and passion for ministry.

He also achieved professional success as a mortician and funeral director, serving families with compassion and dignity. His military service earned him three Purple Hearts, a Bronze Star, and a Silver Star—a testament to his bravery and devotion to duty.

Wayne's faith was the foundation of his life, guiding his every step and touching every soul he encountered.

He is survived by his loving and devoted wife, Susan Holman, who stood by his side through every triumph and trial. He is also survived by his sister Melody Berry, brother Terry Holman, and his beloved children Kyle Holman and his wife Justine, Kirk Holman, and Tiffany Holman. Wayne leaves behind a legacy through his cherished grandchildren Tyler Holman, Savannah Holman, Austin Holman, Kyla Holman, RJ Howell, Gianna Howell, and Jimmy Howell, and great-grandchildren Bentley Holman, Jaxson Holman, and Cashton Holman.
