As an adult she later moved to Arizona with her family for several years, then decided to come back to Fresno where she resided with her mother. Janice was a giver and a helper to anyone who knew her. She would give you anything she had if she knew you needed it more than she did. One of her most famous sayings to all hard times was “THIS TOO SHALL PASS”
