John S Wong was born December 12, 1944, in Guangzhou, China and passed away on October 24, 2024, in Fresno, CA.

He was married and divorced and had no children.

He was born the only child to Wong Cheong Kit and Ko Shuk Chi. The family moved to Hong Kong in 1949. His parents named him Wong Shui Sang because he was born in Guangzhou.

He came to Fresno in 1961 to attend Fresno City College and later Fresno State.

While attending college, he started his career in the restaurant business at the Leilani Restaurant.

In 1970, he took over Fuji Café on Kern St in Chinatown. He transformed Fuji Café into an extremely popular Chinese restaurant in Chinatown. The restaurant received rave reviews from Madeline Davidson, the Fresno Bee food critic during that time. In 1992, deciding it was time to move further north and grow the business, he sold Fuji Café and opened Bamboo Garden at Shaw and West which was the old Loy Loy Restaurant. In 2000, wanting to downsize, he sold Bamboo Garden and would move down the street to Bullard and West and opened Bamboo Garden Take Out. John would eventually retire in 2016.

John enjoyed photography, raising palm plants, woodworking, singing Karaoke, and traveling with friends and family.

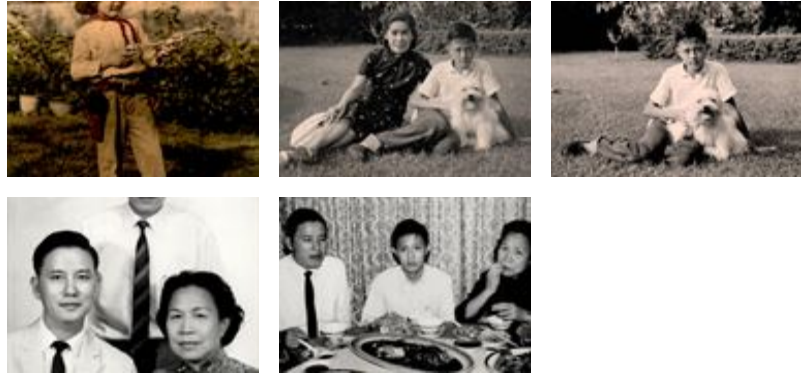
