Jose Villa Benavidez, age 63 passed away surrounded by his loved ones on May 10, 2020 due to Pancreatic Cancer. He was born on June 19, 1956 in Juchipila, Zacatecas but as was typical in those rural areas he was registered much later, on August 12, 1956. He married Ana Maria Lozano Figueroa in Guadalajara, Jalisco on November 17, 1983, who he loved until the very end of his life.

Jose was a family man. He was hard-working, humble, and had the biggest heart. You could usually find him with his family, working, at the local pick-a-part, or at the Remate where he enjoyed spending his weekends passing the time. He was a great man who was not good at sitting still. He was most in his element when at a jobsite and when he was not physically working, he was talking about working. He was also very funny and kept his sense of humor, even during his last days.

He loved his children and grandchildren more than anything. He often said that he did not care about his appearance or being dirty and in ragged clothes because of his line of work. What was important to him was that his children were provided for, clean, and fed. He was not the kind of person that cared about things, he cared about people, especially his people.

Jose will be greatly missed and is survived by his mother Natividad Villa Benavidez; his brothers and sisters, Alfredo Villa, Manuel Villa, Rebecca Villa, Jesus Villa, Gloria Villa, Guadalupe Villa, Irma Villa, Maria Villa, Maria Magdalena Villa, Sergio Villa, Esmeralda Villa, and Francisco Villa; his wife,
