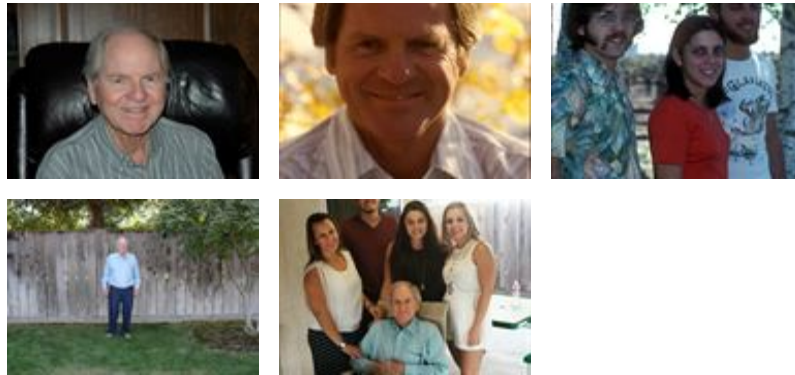

Ken and I have been in touch with each other by e-mail for two or three years, during which time knowing that I am also interested in photography, he shared some of his excellent photos with me.
