Stepping into her home brought you comforting peace.

Lucy found joy in the simple things in life. She found serenity in nature and enjoyed floral gardens and sitting on isolated beaches with her husband, listening to the crashing of ocean waves at sunset. She was proud of her son

and loved being a mother. They would spend hours just talking about life and enjoying each other's company. She treated her nieces and nephews like her own children and held a cherished place for them in her heart.

She enjoyed watching classic black and white movies. She was intrigued with Victorian era stories, classic literature, and vintage postcards, which were echoes of yesteryear.

When she was diagnosed in 2013 with a rare autoimmune disease, her life expectancy was only five more years. But instead of losing hope, she fought with strength and courage through times of wellness and relapse. She was disciplined and wholeheartedly listened to the advice of her medical team. This dedication to health helped her live a total of thirteen more years since diagnosis. When she was hospitalized for the last time, her fighting spirit and steadfast determination were evident to all involved with her care. When she succumbed to the disease, she was surrounded by her loving family, and she died with grace and dignity.

Lucy is survived by her beloved son, David Joshua Malagon; her husband, Ernest Malagon; her parents, David Gutierrez and Virginia Linda Gutierrez; her siblings; and everyone in her extended family, including her mother and father in law, sisters in law, and brothers in law.

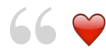
