Melchora B. Salvador was born to Benito and Ruperta Bernabe in Los Angeles, California on January 6, 1932 and passed away on August 2, 2014 in Fresno, California after a courageous battle with cancer.

Meling, as she was known by many, work as a medical biller for Dr. Leah Press and Dr. Marketa Limova at Intelligent Skincare for over 20 years. She was devout catholic and a parishioner of St. Paul Newman Center. Meling was very active in the Filipino community most notably for her service to the Legionarios Del Trabajo in America - Worsipful Anchor Lodge No. 626 of Fresno. Ill. Sis.
