



## Narciso Armijo Mata

October 24, 1924 - June 10, 2020

NARCISO (“NORMAN”) ARMIJO MATA passed away into eternal peace with our heavenly father, surrounded by his loving family on June 10, 2020. Narciso was born to Vicente Mata-Martinez and Pascuala Armijo-Mata on October 24, 1924, in the City of Edinburg, Texas, where he was raised and attended school. In 1943, during World War II, at the young age of 19, Narciso enlisted into the United States Army. During a live training exercise, in preparation to deploy overseas, Narciso was severely injured and received a medical and honorable discharge. In 1945, he married Sophia Salinas and they had two children, Ernesto and Estella, who both continue to reside in the State of Texas. Narciso later moved to Oregon and in 1964 he met and married Maria Frances Puente. They had five children, Norman Jr., Patricia, Albert, Crystal and Frank. In the 1970s, the family moved to Fresno, California, where they all continue to reside. During the 1980s, Norman started his own gardening business which he proudly owned for 20 years. He retired at the young age of 75. Narciso is survived by his wife Frances of 56 years, seven children, and he was grandpa to many grandchildren and great grandchildren.
