Pablo had an unstoppable will and spirit. He never gave up, not even when he had a massive stroke, which doctors said he would not survive. He fought his way back to his family and friends. He enjoyed every moment he had with his family and friends and even though he had slowed down, he still fought daily to do the things he wanted. One of his most cherished and treasured accomplishments was becoming a United States Citizen, which he did, along with Maria on August 20, 2019. He continued live his life, as best as he could and with Maria's help, he found joy in making the backyard of their home a small oasis of love, where they planted flowers and a small garden of vegetables.

Pablo was never scared or hesitant to take on tasks and did everything with honesty and integrity. He had a strong work ethic and was well liked by

everyone, mostly due to his friendly and hardworking attitude. Pablo had an incredible and caring spirit and would always make time to help others. His legacy will carry on forever, reminding us that hard work pays off and so does a caring heart.
