Maria Teresa Avila later married Glendon Blaine Bundy, who raised Pete as his own and was a loving father to Pete. Pete also became a fantastic cook and was an expert chess player who could win in just a few moves and challenged everyone. He was a die-hard Dallas Cowboy fan, and he loved music and especially playing the guitar and drums.

In 1982, Pete married his high school sweetheart, Concepcion (Connie) Gonzales. Pete and Connie conceived seven children between 1982 and 1987, Daniel Hernandez (deceased), Pete Anthony Hernandez III; twin sons Christopher Michael Hernandez and Nicholas Ryan Hernandez; triplet daughters Victoria Nicole Hernandez, Kristina Marie Hernandez, and Angela Joy Hernandez. As a result, the Hernandez family has been blessed with 19 precious grandchildren and continues to grow.

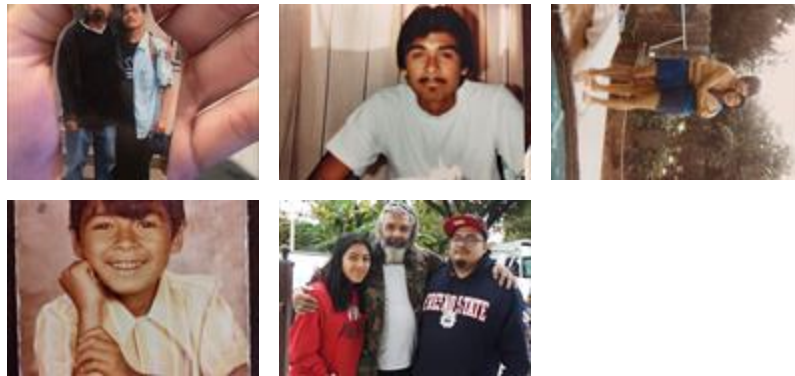

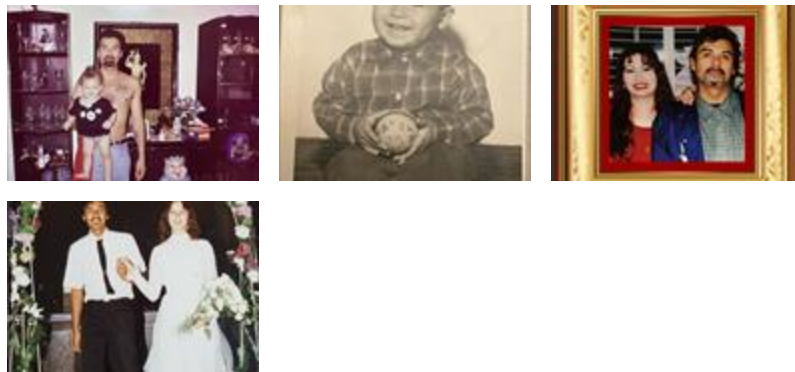

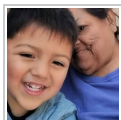
