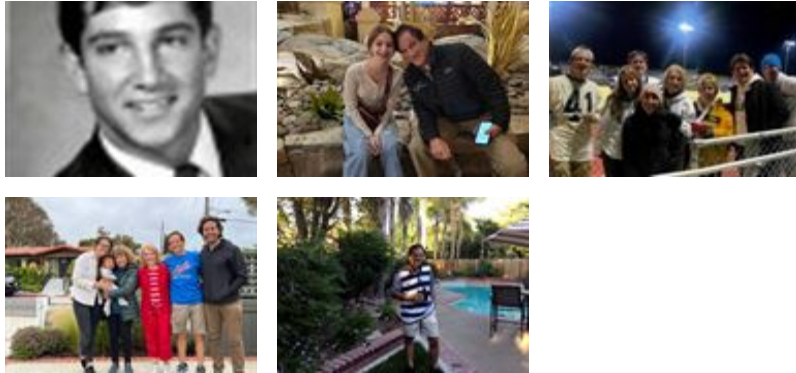

I was thrown into a whole new world, Pete turned out to be the best guide one could ask for...He would become my best friend. Our daily walks included lots of laughter, limericks word games and more puns than anyone could tolerate! He encouraged me to get involved in student council and loads of fun activities. Along with Walt Waggener we were his campaign coordinators specializing in Smothers Brothers themed skits, for Pete's continual runs for leadership positions.

In addition to countless hours shooting baskets in the Musto driveway, Pete taught me how to properly study, which served me well, Graduating University with Honors. When not at work I would watch his games.
