



## Quentin M. Kiggins

February 13, 1942 - November 8, 2023

Quentin Merrill Kiggins, 81, of Fresno, California, passed away peacefully on November 8, 2023. Born on February 13, 1942, to Lloyd Wilbur Kiggins and Jean Shaw Kiggins, Quentin was a man with a deep sense of patriotism and service, and an immense love for his family which he carried throughout his life.

A man of honor and dedication, Quentin served his country by joining the Air Force on October 1, 1960.
