Rito Negrete G3mez passed away peacefully in his sleep on June 15, 2019. He was born on August 3, 1935 in Burbank, California. He was preceded in death by his parents, Rito Leon G3mez and Maria Mares Negrete and his sister, Herlinda G3mez Moreno. He is survived by his sister, Adelina "Lina" N. G3mez and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

While living in East Los Angeles, in December, 1949, his parents decided to move to Fresno where he was enrolled in San Joaquin Memorial High School from which he graduated in 1952.
