After a long illness following a fall, Bob passed away at home. Born in San Francisco to Robert and Billie Ogle. Bob and mother moved to Fresno after his father's death in 1924. Bob graduated from Fresno High School in 1941. He attended Fresno State College and UCLA where he was very active in theatre arts.

He served honorably in the U.S. Army, being awarded two Purple Hearts during the heaviest fighting at the Battle of the Bulge.

After his discharge, Bob returned to San Francisco, where he met and married the love of his life, Helen Andrews. They resided in San Francisco and decided to move to Fresno to pursue careers in education at F.S.C.

Bob began his teaching career at McLane High School where he taught Drama for twenty years, directing numerous plays and musicals, delighting students with his naughty sense of humor.

While they were not teaching, Bob and Helen traveled the world, making many friends.

Robert is preceded in death by his parents and his wife Helen. He is survived by his sisters-in-law, Peggy Stephenson and her children Michelle and Jimmy, Daisy Mosner and her children Chris and Michael and cousin Jeff Blum.

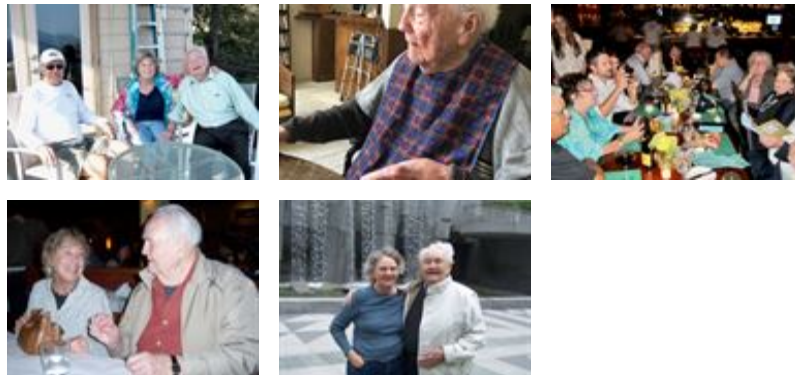
