Sam se mantuvo fuerte y positivo sabiendo en sus últimos días que Dios estaba con El y que nunca lo había dejado.

Unfortunately, after the loss of his father when he was very young, he did not have a positive father figure to continue guiding him in his growth and development to be a God-fearing son and father. Over time, he left the church and his home and moved to live with his friends who were not a good influence on him, and we all know that he battled addictions that changed the course of his life, taking him down hard and painful paths for him and his family and children, all those life experiences shaped the person he was. Despite everything, her mother never stopped praying for her sons. He also lived in Turlock where his children Michael and Ashley Varela were born, eventually moving to Hayward Ca. Where his youngest daughter Abby Varela was born.

The best days of his Life happened to be when his children were born . He was known for his big heart, his jokes that made everyone laugh, his stories that he always shared with people, his good memory to remember details and his grateful attitude, we cannot also forget that he had a strong character, you had to know him very well to understand that person that He was.

But most of all, Sam loved his family.

He is survived by his two brothers Daniel and Mike Varela and his sister Abby Alejo, his best friend who was like another brother Pepe Salazar and his son Michel and his two daughters Ashley and Abby, many cousins, nephews and nieces. They meant a lot to him and he enjoyed spending time with all of them.

Sam also stood out for his talent for working on wood and tile floors, doing impeccable work with great detail. He liked to be with his family, go fishing, camping, and spend time with them and his children when possible. He always expressed how happy and proud of all his children, who were able to get ahead even though he couldn't always be there for them. He was a fan of the Raiders, of his cars, and we all know that he always liked to dress well and look elegant at all times, even his pajamas were elegant.

Sam was detected with a cancerous tumor on his forehead and he had 7 operations to correct his skull, several times his cancer was in remission, He fought for 10 years against cancer, which was multiple myeloma, and finally, after all possible treatments, he could not overcome the leukemia, but he fought hard until the end, cared for and assisted by his personal assistant and friend Sandra, who helped him in everything and endured everything his way of Being and also his cousin Sylvia and Gloria who opened the doors of their home for him and helped in his treatment and always being aware of him. Sam stayed strong and positive knowing in his final days that God was with him and that he had never left him.

The weekend before he died he had an open heart for the things of God, on Saturday his brothers Mike and Abby were with him praying for him, listening to sermons that were giving him faith, and finally on Sunday Sam got up early and He was eager to attend Church where God made a change in Him through the touch of the Holy Spirit and He spoke in Tongues again. From then on he said that he had never felt so spiritually light and at peace. That Night his brother Daniel came to visit and Samuel was very happy to spend some time with him praying and talking about the things of God.

The Lord took him to rest four days later on April 11, 2024 in Fresno Ca. Even though Sam is greatly missed, we know that He is in the presence of the Lord

because the word of God reminds us that to be absent to the Body is to be present with the Lord.

Today, as we remember Sam, let us hold on to the good times we shared with him. From his infectious laugh to his positive outlook on life, Sam brought joy to everyone around him.

We will miss him, but we will keep his memory alive in our hearts.
