She was the oldest girl of 10 children. In the middle of the Great Depression she had to help raise and feed the family. With only 3 years of schooling she earned an 8th grade education. As a mother, she raised 3 children while taking work from farm labor to assembling electronic equipment to hauling twin trailers to operating drive in theaters. She broke through glass ceilings before feminism was an idea.
