



## Stuart Home

July 21, 1937 - April 25, 2023

Walter Stuart Home, II was born in Los Angeles, California on July 21, 1937. He passed away in Fresno on April 25, 2023 at the age of 85.

Stuart attended Saint Paul the Apostle Catholic School in Westwood, California and Santa Monica City College. He transferred to the University of California at Los Angeles and graduated in 1959 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Bacteriology.

After graduating from UCLA, he was drafted by the U. S. Army. After his basic training at Fort Ord, where he became a member of the US Army Pistol Team, he was assigned to Fort Baker in San Rafael, California. At Fort Baker, Stuart worked in the medical laboratory specializing in infectious diseases.

After completion of active duty service in the Army, Stuart earned his law degree from the Hastings College of Law. In January of 1966 he was sworn in.

Stuart opened his own law practice after working for other firms for twelve years. In 2009, he moved his office into his home and continued to practice law until his death. In 2020, Stuart was recognized by the California State Association for his 50 plus years of service to the legal profession.

Stuart was a very curious man and had many interests which included

photography, horseback riding, skeet shooting, backpacking and flying. He was also an amateur radio operator for 57 years and served as President of the Fresno Area Ham Radio Club for the past 12 years.

He is survived by his loving wife Phyllis; his son Walter Stuart "Trey" Home III; daughter Heather Beard and her husband Brian; and four grandchildren.

Visitation will be at Chapel of the Light Funeral Home on Thursday, May 11, 2023 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

A Funeral Mass will be celebrated at the Shrine of Saint Therese Catholic Church, 855 E. Floradora Avenue at Wishon Avenue in Fresno on Friday, May 12, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. Interment will follow at Belmont Memorial Park.

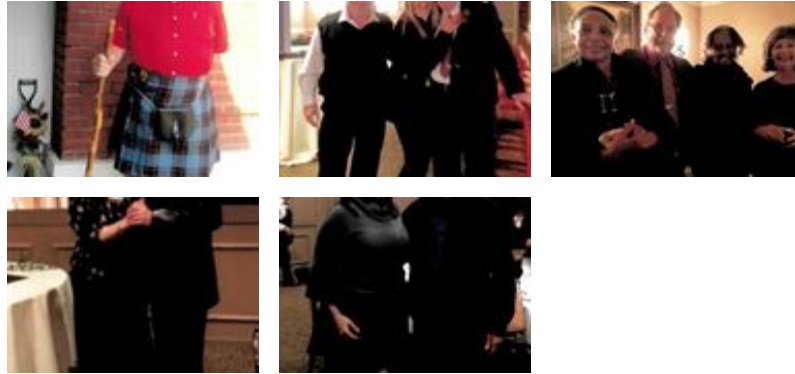
