He collected aluminum cans and cashed them in for the benefit of the Sunday school department. He played the steel guitar at 9th and Lowe. He bought a bass fiddle from Sears catalog and played it for many years in church. He was a member of Truth Tabernacle for 72 years. He was loved and will be missed by all of us.
