



## Wilfredo V. Fontanilla

September 15, 1930 - October 25, 2020

Wilfredo "Eddie" Villasas Fontanilla was born in Manila, Philippines on September 15, 1930. He peacefully passed away surrounded by his loving family at his home on October 25, 2020 at the age of 90.

Eddie will be remembered by his loving wife Milburga C. His family and friends knew him as a kind, thoughtful, funny, generous, and mild-mannered loving father and husband. He was a fighter as he fought his lung disease for so many years. He was known to nurses and doctors who took care of him at the VA Hospital as funny and friendly.

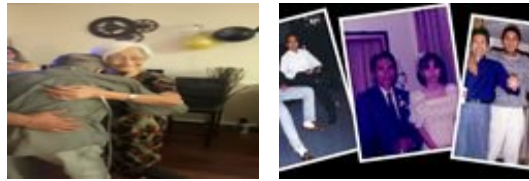
